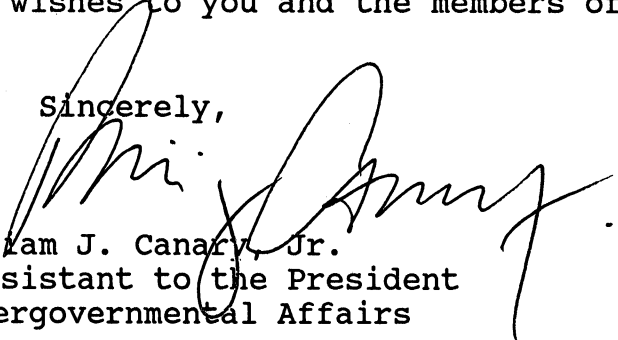
Dear Mr. Flynn:
