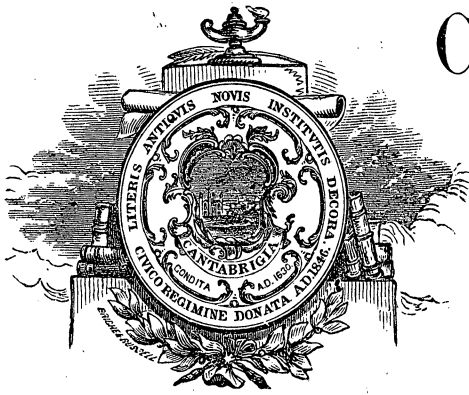




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.
