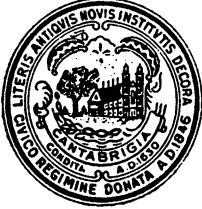

AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an ordinance formerly entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge" as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter 2 entitled: "Administration" Article XXII entitled: "Officers Generally" Section 2-192, List of Salaries - Fire Department as amended on June 25, 1973 is further amended by adding at the end thereof three new paragraphs which read as follows:

In order to recognize and compensate the members of the Fire Department who are covered by this ordinance, for their years of service, and actual experience gained in the hazardous duties of a firefighter, the members of the Fire Department will receive a percentage of their present salaries as outlined above based on their years of service in the Fire Department according to the following schedule:

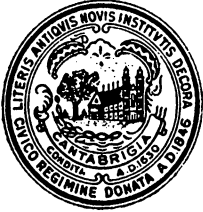
3% for 10 years service
6% for 15 years service
10% for 20 years service
20% for 25 years service

In the event that the members of the Fire Department are awarded academic credits based on educational incentive programs or any courses of study authorized by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts or the City of Cambridge then in the event, a member of the Fire Department shall be paid the greater amount under the applicable law or ordinance.

This amendment shall take effect the thirtieth day of June, 1975.
