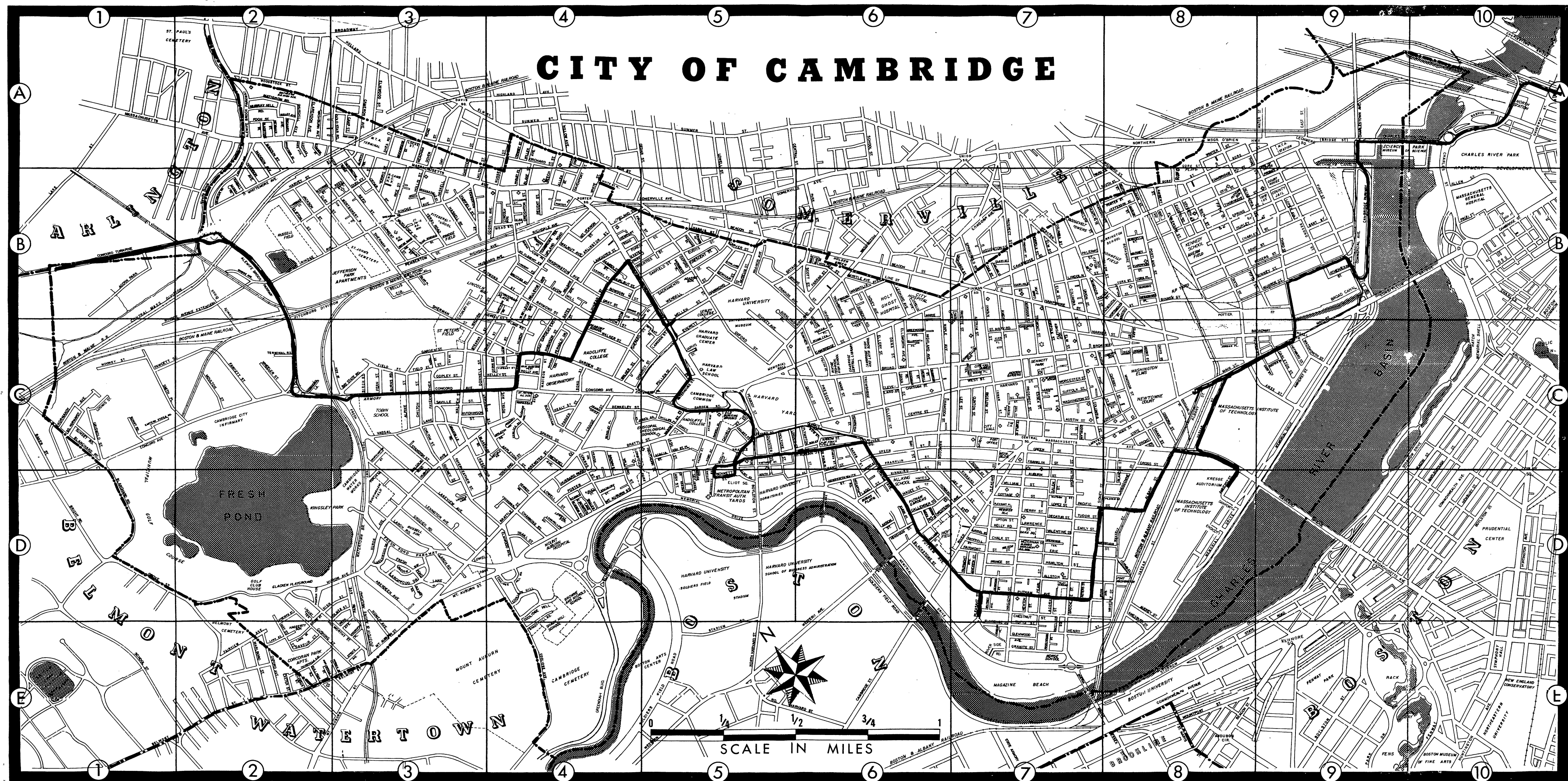

Please be advised that under the provisions of chapter 159A of the General Laws, it is necessary:-

- (1) To obtain a local license from each of the cities and/or towns in or through which it is proposed to operate (sec. 1). Such license or licenses shall specify the public ways within each municipality over and upon which it is proposed to conduct the operation (sec. 2).
- (2) To file a petition with the Department stating that the applicant has received the necessary local licenses under sec. 1 (naming the municipalities), and requesting that the Department issue certificate of public convenience and necessity (sec. 7), authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in the aforementioned municipalities (describe route in detail in each of the municipalities involved).
- (3) The petition should be filed in duplicate.
  - (a) Copy of local license or licenses shall be attached to original copy.
  - (b) A map showing the proposed route (outlined in crayon) shall be attached to each copy.
- (4) A filing fee of \$10.00 shall accompany the petition (chapter 630 of the Acts of 1963).
- (5) Upon receipt of the petition, a public hearing will be scheduled giving fourteen (14) days notice to all parties of interest, at which time it will be necessary that you show that public convenience and necessity require the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire, as prayed for in the petition.

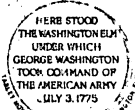

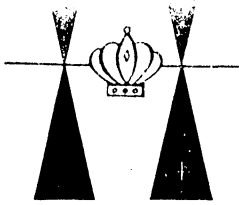


