TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL:

RE: Obstructions on sidewalk at 14 Story Street

General Ordinances, Section 17-40, Paragraph A provides as follows:

"No person shall place, or cause to be placed, upon any sidewalk, any article whatsoever so as to obstruct a free passage for travelers for more than fifteen (15) minutes."

Section 9-20 of the General Ordinances provides that all electric or utility poles located on sidewalks shall be set upon the outer edge thereof and where there are curbstones shall be within four (4") inches of the inner edge of the curbstone.

Section 17-29 provides that no person shall make an opening in any sidewalk to serve as a receptacle for any article without a license from the Superintendent of Streets authorized by the City Council.

In the absence of compliance with the above Ordinances, the condition which you described to me in your communication of December 14, 1972, is in violation of the City Ordinances.
