IN CITY COUNCIL
December 8, 1986

- WHEREAS: Lead paint is a hazard to people, especially to small children and pregnant women; and
- WHEREAS: Landlords are responsible under the law for deleading apartments using very specific procedures; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report on:
1. any deleading program that the City is overseeing or sponsoring, including how lead hazards are reported to the City;
 2. the protocol followed by the City in supervising the deleading of apartments;
 3. the procedure a tenant should follow to ensure that an apartment is properly delead; and
 4. the procedure a prospective tenant with children should follow if denied an apartment due to leadpainting.
