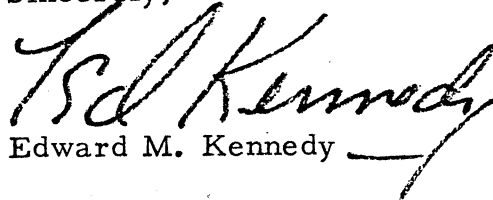

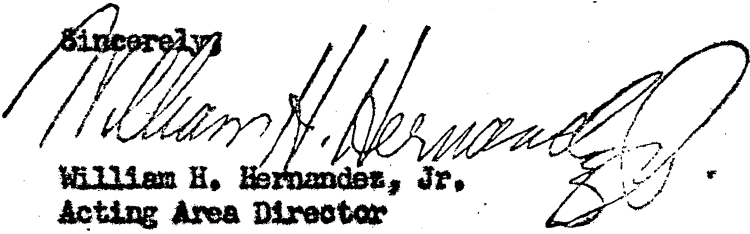
Dear Senator Kennedy:

This letter is in response to your inquiry of April 25, 1974, concerning the proposed demolition of a Greek revival structure in the Cambridge Model Neighborhood, and whether HUD could be of assistance in preserving the building.

At present, HUD is reviewing the recent Federal Model Cities appropriation, and is determining the allocations which will be available to each city. The funds which Cambridge will receive may be used to assist in the preservation of the structure if this activity falls within the established local priorities for the Model Neighborhood.

We do concur in the expressed opinion of the Historical Commission that recognizes the need to preserve those structures exemplifying certain aspects of past history. We are in contact with local officials in an attempt to continue to lend whatever assistance we can.
