Dear Sir:

In reply to your letter with copies of orders adopted by the City Council of Cambridge on November 22, would inform you, in connection with the order requesting the Metropolitan District Commission to consider equipping the locker building at Magazine Beach with shower baths, that shower baths are operated on both the women's and men's sides of the bath house.

In regard to the order requesting the Metropolitan District Commission to consider locating lights to be operated by hand for the protection of pedestrians while crossing Memorial Drive at the junction of Magazine Street, would inform you that during the season for bathing an officer is assigned to the vicinity of the bath house and a large part of his duties consists in doing traffic work at the junction of Magazine Street and Memorial Drive. During the remainder of the year pedestrian traffic is so light that there is no need of traffic lights at the present time.
