Upon petition of Trustees of Boston Metropolitan District for approval of maturities and interest rates of \$1,801,000 of bonds of the District, 1960 Series A, the Commission of the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Monday the thirtieth day of November, 1959 at ten o'clock in the forenoon.

And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least 14 days prior to said date in newspapers having a general circulation in the City of Boston, and to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least 14 days prior to said date on the Mayor and City Clerk of the cities of Boston, Cambridge, Chelsea, Everett, Medford, Malden, Revere, Newton and Somerville, and on the Chairman of the Board of Selectmen and Town Clerk of the towns of Arlington, Belmont, Brookline, Milton and Watertown, and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.
