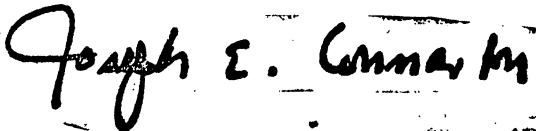
COUNCILLOR RUSSELL
