That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the City Solicitor to confer with the Honorable Francis Murray, Judge of the Federal District Court at Boston, to determine the allegations of legal delays and dilatory tactics which could be employed to obstruct the construction of the Kennedy Library Complex on the site which was given to the Kennedy Library Corporation upon payment of more than six million dollars to the Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority from public funds of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Solicitor be authorized to engage special counsel in this matter, if he deems it necessary.
