At a meeting of the Emergency Finance Board of the Commonwealth, held on the 6th day of September, 1973, a majority of said Board being present, the following vote was passed:

VOTED: To approve for the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE, the project of Constructing, Originally Equipping and Furnishing a Branch Library in the Central Square Area, as shown by the application on file, being Project No. 72-1; also to approve the Offer to and Acceptance by the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE of a Grant from the United States Commissioner of Education under Title II of the Library Services and Construction Act in the amount of SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000.00); the use of FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00) from the 1972 Tax Levy; and SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$6,000.00) from the 1973 Tax Levy; and the borrowing of SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$680,000.00) in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 44, Section 7, Clause (3) of the General Laws, as amended, as voted by the City Council on February 28, 1972 and August 6th, 1973.

Any amount to be borrowed for said Project 72-1 under the provisions of this vote shall be reduced by any Federal Funds received as a contribution towards the cost of said Project.

Authorization for the above project is in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 74 of the Acts of 1945, as amended.

At a meeting of the Emergency Finance Board of the Commonwealth, held on the 6th day of September, 1973, a majority of said Board being present, the following vote was passed:

VOTED: To approve for the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE, the project of Remodeling, Reconstructing or Making Extraordinary Repairs to the Cambridge Home for the Aged and Infirm, as shown by the application on file, also to approve the Offer to and Acceptance by the CITY OF CAMERIDGE of a Federal Grant of FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000.00) under the Hill-Burton Program (Public Law 91-296); and the use of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000.00) from the 1973 Tax Levy; and the borrowing of TWO MILLION, SIX HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,650,000.00) in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 44, Section 7, Clause (3A) of the General Laws, as amended, as approved by this Board under date of April 3rd, 1973.

Any amount to be borrowed for said Project under the provisions of this vote shall be reduced by any Federal and/or State Funds received as a contribution towards the cost of said project.

Authorization for the above project is in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 74 of the Acts of 1945, as amended.
