- WHEREAS: He brought to Cambridge High and Latin School in Cambridge, Boston College and Suffolk University Law School, from all of which he graduated, that same respect he brought to the U.S. Marine Corps in which he served as a Sergeant during the Korean Conflict. Among other accomplishments, he distinguished himself as past president of the Middlesex Bar Association, the Cambridge Young Democrats and past Grand Knight of the North Cambridge Knights of Columbus; and
- WHEREAS: During his illness, his faith, patience and persistence gave an added special dimension to the meaning of confronting challenge with "grace under pressure". His wife and children added a special personal profile to the meaning of a family who cared, shared and supported a husband and father to the ultimate degree; now therefore be it
