MAYOR DANEHY

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Police Officers John White and James Dwyer affected an arrest of five persons on February 6, 1979 culminating a series of breaks and robberies within the Central Square area; and
- WHEREAS: Officers White and Dwyer, during this normal patrol, responded to a breaking and entering call at 288 Green Street and found several coin operated machines forced open and an M-1 Rifle taken from the premises; and
- WHEREAS: Shortly after this call, Police Headquarters received an anonymous telephone call indicating that five youths had just left the building where the break occurred and gave a description of one of the youths and further stated that this person possibly could be on Auburn Street; and
- WHEREAS: Officers White and Dwyer, under the direction of Sergeant Irwin Nolan, immediately responded to the Auburn Street address and requested to go inside to speak to the occupants of the apartment; and
- WHEREAS: One of the occupants matched the description of one of the youths who had fled the scene, Officers White and Dwyer requested this individual to go to Police Headquarters where after further questioning the individual indicated he was involved in the robbery and supplied additional information allowing for the subsequent arrest of four other individuals; and
- WHEREAS: Almost all of the stolen property had been recovered as a result of a comprehensive search by these two officers which required them to work nearly all day and night in an effort to resolve not only this break but many others in the Central Square area; now therefore be it

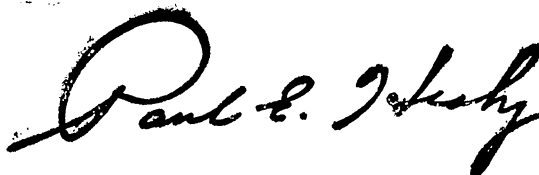
RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere congratulations for a job well done to Officers John White and James Dwyer; and be it further
