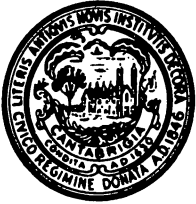

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Cambridge Housing Authority for \$83,542.00 to the Human Services Salary & Wages Account \$73,179.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$10,363.00 to provide funds for Remedial Education to adult population at the CHA developments, especially Newtowne Court, Jefferson Park, Washington Elms, Roosevelt Towers, Putnam Gardens and Woodrow Wilson Court. Funds will cover costs of one project manager, one half of one teacher and one quarter of administrative help as well as supplies and operating costs.
