NOTICE OF SURRENDER OF PRELIMINARY PERMIT

(December 16, 1986)

Take notice that the Burlington Energy Development Associates, permittee for the Cochrane Dam Project No. 9333, has requested that the preliminary permit be terminated. The preliminary permit for Project No. 9333 was issued on December 13, 1985, and would have expired on November 30, 1988. The project would have been located on the Charles River, in Norfolk County, Massachusetts.

The permittee filed the request on November 13, 1986, and the preliminary permit for Project No. 9333 shall remain in effect through the thirtieth day after issuance of this notice unless that day is a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday as described in 18 C.F.R. §385.2007, in which case the permit shall remain in effect through the first business day following that day. New applications involving this project site, to the extent provided for under 18 C.F.R. Part 4, may be filed on the next business day.

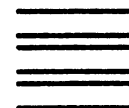
