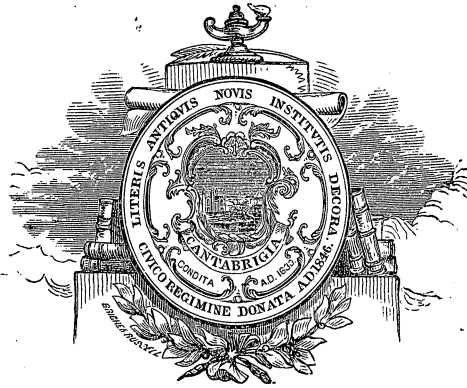


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, Sept. 13. 1865.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that Clark Street, so called, between Harvard Street and Hampshire Street should be

laid out as a public highway, it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to the shewmen on said Clark Street, and all other persons interested,

that this Board intends to lay out the Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as a public street—and that Wednesday, the 27th day of September, ^{current} at eight o'clock, P. M., is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
