As you requested, I have had Mr. Steve Harper survey the parking situation at Jefferson Park over the last several weeks from June 30 to August 10. His findings have been virtually the same each evening. Behind the management building at Jefferson Park, there are approximately 18 spaces each evening. He also surveyed the parking on Rindge Ave. directly across from our development. Only one car showed a Jefferson Park parking sticker.

Nevertheless, I have instructed the manager to inform all residents about parking within Jefferson Park. If you need more information, please let me know.
