RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the award winners and the Chamber of Commerce.

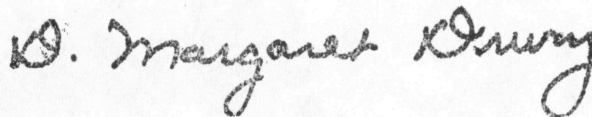
