WHEREAS: Senator Kennedy has introduced a bill entitled "National and Community Service Act of 1989," which, in part, would make grants available to states and local applicants to create or expand opportunities for students and out-of-school youth and for community members, especially senior citizens, to volunteer in schools; and

WHEREAS: One section of this comprehensive bill provides grants for innovative projects that encourage student participation in community service activities before, during or after the completion of the student's higher education; and

WHEREAS: The participation in this volunteer education program will provide for partial loan relief for these volunteer students similar to service in the Peace Corps or Vista; and

WHEREAS: This City Council is committed to the development of programs for students at risk and for drop-out prevention; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record endorsing the National and Community Service Act of 1989; and be it further

RESOLVED: That this City Council send immediately to Senator Kennedy our congratulations and support for his creation of this comprehensive bill as this bill is expected to be considered by Congress in the near future.
