Cambridge, MA — "The Unitarian Universalist Service Committee has purchased the remaining 13,000 square feet of office condominium space at 130 Prospect Street, which will serve as its corporate headquarters," said Thomas Johnson, Vice President of IRB Commercial, who brokered the transaction.

130 Prospect Street, originally the Saint Mary's Gymnasium building, was converted by Cambridge Development Corporation in 1989 to 1,000 sf of first class office space.
