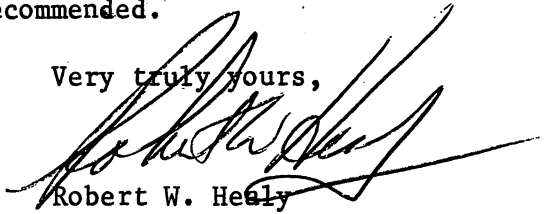

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a donation from the Winthrop Park Trust, Inc., for \$105,000 to the Public Investment Extraordinary Expenditure account to provide funds for the Trust's share of the construction and first year maintenance of Winthrop Square Park. After an unsuccessful application to the Executive Office of Environmental Affairs, the City joined with Harvard University's Public Space Partnership Program to develop a public/private partnership to finance the reconstruction of Winthrop Square Park. The Public Space Partnership Program established the Winthrop Park Trust, Inc. to raise and administer the balance of funds necessary for construction and 50% of the first year maintenance costs. The appropriation of \$105,000 will provide \$79,116 toward construction, \$23,984 for contingency as needed, and \$3,300 for maintenance. The City's share of \$75,000 for construction and \$3,300 for maintenance has been appropriated in the FY 87 Capital Budget.

Passage of the enclosed order is recommended.
