This City Council learned with deep regret of the death of Reverend Joseph D. Meredith, pastor of St. Patrick's Church, Cambridge, on July 8, 1969, and

WHEREAS:-

Father Meredith was born in Newton, graduated from Boston College and prepared for the priesthood at St. John's Seminary, Brighton prior to his ordination by Cardinal O'Connell at Holy Cross Cathedral in Boston in May of 1927, and

WHEREAS:-

Reverend Joseph D. Meredith had a long and distinguished career in the priesthood having served as an assistant at Blessed Sacrament Church, Jamaica Plain; Sacred Heart, Watertown; St. Agatha's, Milton; Blessed Sacrament, Greenwood; St. Edward's, Brockton; All Saints, Roxbury; St. John's, North Chelmsford; St. Stephen's, Boston and as Chaplain of the Boston School for the Deaf in Randolph, and

WHEREAS:-

Reverend Joseph D. Meredith was named pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Kingston in 1951 prior to his appointment as pastor of St. Patrick's Church, Cambridge in 1958, and

WHEREAS:-

In the death of Reverend Joseph D. Meredith the City of Cambridge has lost an outstanding clergyman who performed his priestly duties in a quiet and effective manner, therefore be it

That the City Council joins with his family and friends in sorrow at their great loss, and be it further
