- WHEREAS: Francis J. Nolan served the City of Cambridge for thirty-four years, from January 5, 1942 until his retirement on December 29, 1976 as Supervisor of the Printing Department, where his diligence, courtesy and managerial ability was in keeping with the highest standards of public service; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: By the members of the Cambridge City Council in meeting assembled this third day of May, 1982 that we do hereby express our sorrow at the passing of Francis J. Nolan and, acknowledging the great contributions of his public service, extend to his widow Alice and to his fine son Joseph, devoted daughter Elaine and sister Mary Noonan, our most sincere condolences; and be it further
