The Committee on Roads and Bridges of this board,
to which was referred the petition of Mather Bros., for
the completion of sidewalk on the southerly side of
Haward street, between Columbus and Pine streets,

hearing has been given upon this petition, and it
appears that there are two estates only, that would
be liable to assessment in case the petition should be
granted. The owner of one of the estates, objects to the
improvement. Inasmuch as your committee has
already expended of this kind laid out to cover the
amount appropriated therefor, it does not seem to be
expedient to have this done in face of the opposition
of one of the abutters, particularly, as the public necessity
does not seem to demand said improvement. Your committee
would therefore recommend that the petitioners have leave
to withdraw.
