Subject: Sewer Construction Grants

The City Council on June 23, 1975, authorized you to file an application for Federal Funds for sewer construction. On November 17, 1975, the City Council also authorized you to file an application for State Funds in addition to the Federal Funds. At the time these applications were filed the amount of the grants was unknown. This was because the City of Cambridge had a low priority as far as the State and Federal participation.

After numerous meetings we have been successful in obtaining funds. We have now been notified that we will receive the following amounts:

Phase 2 Sewer Construction - State Funds	- \$ 115,168
Federal Funding	- 575,838
Phase 3 Construction - State Funds	- 645,799
Federal Funding	- \$3,228,997

This represents a total receipt of grants to date of - \$4,565,802

I believe the City Council must vote to accept these funds, and make an appropriation to the Public Works Department, in order to begin this construction. I am presently meeting with the State and Federal Government to obtain additional funding for Phase 4 sewer construction.

I request that the Council vote to authorize the City through your office to apply for these additional Federal Funds. I feel that the City has been fortunate to receive these funds, and believe we can make a very concerted effort to obtain this additional funding in the next fiscal year.
