Based upon the Environmental Protection Agency estimate that 40-60% of all litter by volume is beverage containers that could be recycled and that 8% of solid waste trucked by cities is such containers; therefore be it

That the City Manager be requested to cause an estimate to be made of the annual cost to Cambridge of the failure of the General Court to enact this Bottle Bill.
