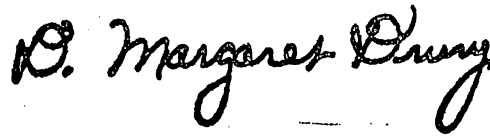

WHEREAS: This year 1000 women from more than 150 countries have been jointly nominated for the famous Nobel Peace Prize; and

WHEREAS: Four Boston Area women, including two from Cambridge, are among those in nomination for the Nobel Peace Prize. The nominated women have committed themselves daily to the cause of peace and justice.

Kip Tiernan, founder of Rosie's Place, the nation's first homeless women's shelter has devoted her entire life to women's economic empowerment;

Betty Burkes of Cambridge, a former Montessori School teacher in Wellfleet and former President of the US branch of the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, is involved in international peaceful conflict resolution and member of the Cambridge Peace Commission;

Elise Boulding, co-founder of the International Peace Research Association with her husband, Kenneth, served as its secretary-general and was an International President of the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom;

Swanee Hunt of Cambridge, former US Ambassador to Austria, the Director of the Women and Public Policy Program at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government;
