ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the City Solicitor to draft a technically appropriate Home Rule Petition relative to the Promotion of Water Department Employees in the City of Cambridge, containing the following content, for submission to the General Court of the Commonwealth for its approval:

Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the following provisions pertaining to Water Department employees shall be in effect in the City of Cambridge:

Employees of the Water Department engaged in the areas of filtration and purification may substitute experience in such areas for testing for successive grade increases and certification for drinking water supply operators as follows:

Three full years of experience equals Grade 1
Seven full years of experience equals Grade 2
Nine full years of experience equals Grade 3
Twelve full years of experience equals Grade 4.

And, be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager provide this requested draft to this Council as soon as possible.
