Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads ^{and} Bridges be authorized to advertise for proposals for building a sea-wall at Third Street Bridge, the same to be in accordance with plans drawn by the City Engineer. Also, to cause such sea-wall to be built either by contract or by the day under the direction of the City Engineer, at the option of said Committee. The expense thereof not to exceed the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to be charged to the appropriation for Bridges.
