~~Ordered~~, Whereas a Private way in Ward four, called Jennings Street, has been heretofore devoted to the public use by the owners of the adjoining lands and is now in a fit condition to become a public highway, and Whereas it is adjudged by the Mayor & Aldermen that the Public convenience and necessity require that said Street be laid out as a Public Highway and that no persons will be damaged thereby or be entitled to any compensation from the City; therefore Ordered, That said Private Way be & hereby is laid out and established as a Public Highway, by the name of Jennings Street, according to a plan thereof drawn by C. W. Holborn dated Aug. 20th 1860. & according to the plan drawn by Peter Tipton, recorded in Middlesex Registry of Deeds, Book of Plans No 2 Page 20-, the first of said plans being now on file in the office of the City Clerk. Provisos nevertheless that this order shall be of no effect until said Street shall be graded to the satisfaction of this Board by the abutters on said Street.
