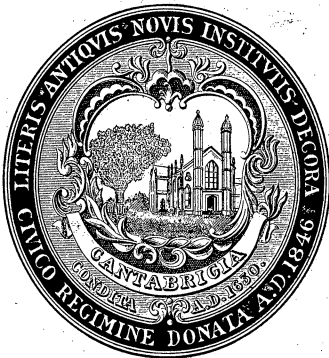

Honorable the City Council of the

City of Cambridge:-

In view of the present limited borrowing capacity of the City and the fact that at the beginning of the year 1917 a new borrowing capacity will be established in accordance with law, and, in view of the importance of the immediate construction of an addition to the High and Latin School building, I respectfully recommend that the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.) dollars be appropriated for this purpose, and that the sum so appropriated be met by the creation of a city debt, as authorized by Ch. 719, acts of the year 1913, sec 5 (3).

I make this recommendation at this time with the confidence that the City Council of the year 1917 will provide an additional appropriation sufficient to complete the construction of the addition to this building as contemplated.

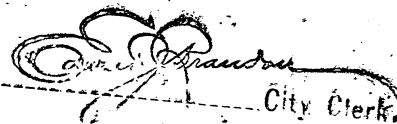
