RE: Mr. Shanti Renfrew

Mr. Renfrew alleges that he has been singled out for illegal ticketing. From my investigation this appears not to be true.

1. The car with North Carolina plates he mentioned in his letter has been tagged 17 times between January 12, 1995 and June 7, 1994. The owner has paid most but not all of his tickets. The car is not boot eligible. The owner currently owes the city \$185.00 in outstanding fines.

2. Mr. Renfrew has been ticketed repeatedly since 1987. During the period when the North Carolina plate received 17 tickets, Mr. Renfrew received none.

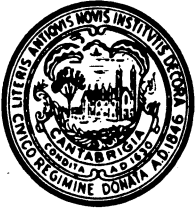
3. Mr. Renfrew's vehicles have received 52 tickets between 1987 and 1993. Only 7 of those tickets have been paid. He currently owes the City \$1,645.00 which includes a \$250.00 fee for the towing of his abandoned vehicle.

4. From 1987 to 1988 Mr. Renfrew had 6 different Mass. license plates and 3 different Mass. driver's licenses. All the Mass. plates have expired and his Mass. license is marked by the Registry as nonrenewable.

5. From 1989 to 1993 his vehicles were registered in New Hampshire. During that period, he had 11 different plates. His New Hampshire license was issued 9/6/89 and expired 4/18/93. His New Hampshire license is listed as non-renewable.

6. In 1992 his vehicle was towed as an abandoned car.

The pattern of changing plates, licenses and residential addresses indicates that Mr. Renfrew was attempting to avoid being booted and put on Registry hold. He has made little attempt to pay his parking fines as he only paid one since 1988.

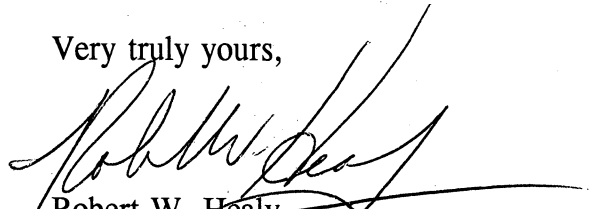
