New England Telephone and Telegraph Company ("NET") is proposing to offer a Billing Information Service ("BIS") to Information Providers, entities who offer recorded or interactive programs, under other NET proposed services. The BIS will be offered only to information providers who elect to do their own billing or for whom NET will not provide billing. The service will provide an end user's name, address and calling number, as well as the called number, date, time and duration of the call.

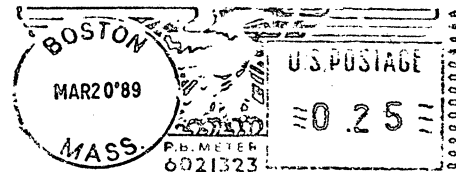
