An Ordinance,  
establishing the Salary of the Super-  
intendent of Streets of the City of  
Cambridge,

Be it ordained, by the City-Council of  
the City of Cambridge, as follows: There  
shall hereafter be paid to the superintend-  
ent of Streets of the City of Cambridge an  
annual salary of six hundred dollars  
in equal quarterly payments of one hundred  
and fifty-dollars each; which shall be  
in full for services rendered in his  
official capacity.
