WHEREAS: This City Council has made a commitment to not raise property taxes; and

WHEREAS: Taxes raised from (new) growth are the only form of revenue which can be raised outside the limitations imposed by the Proposition 2 1/2 levy limit; and

WHEREAS: Maintaining our current commercial tax base, relieves residents of a larger property tax burden and is crucial to fulfill the Council's goal of no tax increases; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Assistant City Manager for Community Development and the Assistant City Manager for Fiscal Affairs to arrange a presentation before the full City Council to describe the long term plans and efforts being made to retain the current commercial tax base, as well as a strategy to encourage economic development in appropriate locations in Cambridge and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the City Solicitor to determine whether it is proper to invite Charis of the Planning Board and the Board of Zoning Appeal to attend to hear the presentation and if so, invite them.
