- WHEREAS: Share Our Strength, one of the nation's leading anti-hunger, anti-poverty organizations, began in the basement of a row house on Capitol Hill in 1984; and
- WHEREAS: In the beginning, Share Our Strength organized a handful of chefs to cook for fundraisers. Today it mobilizes thousands of individuals in the culinary industry to organize events, host dinners, teach cooking and nutrition classes to low-income families and serve as anti-hunger advocates; and
- WHEREAS: Since its founding, Share Our Strength has invested nearly \$70 million in more than 1,000 local, state, national and international organizations working to prevent the causes and consequences of hunger and poverty; and
- WHEREAS: Share Our Strength is fueled by a simple but powerful philosophy: It takes more than food to fight hunger. Through creative events and programs, chefs, restaurateurs, authors and artists as well as accountants, consultants and business executives help raise awareness and funds to end hunger and poverty; and
- WHEREAS: On Sunday, June 15, 2003 Joe Sousa is holding a charity road race: Sousa's Rock Road Race to benefit Share Our Strength at the Fresh Pond Reservoir in Cambridge, MA; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record extending its wish for a very successful fundraiser and to thank Joe Sousa for all he does to help put an end to hunger in the United States; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of the resolution to Joe Sousa on behalf of the entire City Council.
