Upon every complaint received by this division I personally spoke with the complainants and immediate action was taken.

Janet Rose P.R. for McDonalds was most Co-operative to maintaining outside areas.

Ijazz, Manager in charge of Churchs Fried Chicken has had problems from time to time but made every effort to maintaining outside areas.

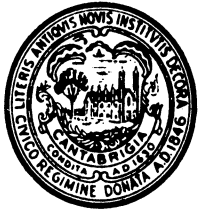

On 4/13/90 I met with Ed Watson Manager of Churchs Fried Chicken. I explained my purpose for this visit regarding the storage and disposal of refuse.

Mr. Watson explained that Popeyes Famous Fried Chicken will be taking over the restaurant. I checked with the License Commission and was informed that the paper work is in progress.

Mr. Watson stated that all accumulated refuse is stored in the restaurant. Refuse is picked up every day except on Sundays.

A Sanitary Inspector from this division will be making more frequent visits.
