ORDERED:

That, in accordance with an ordinance relative to gasoline swing arms over the sidewalk, the Superintendent of Streets be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Giovanni Salvato for the erection of a swing arm at 194 Western Avenue.

Provided that, before permission is granted to the aforesaid petitioner, he shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said swing arm.

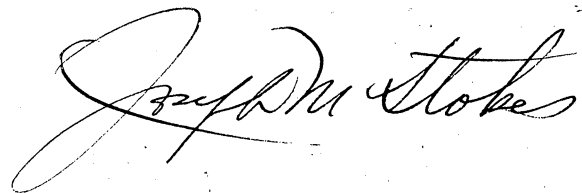
