- WHEREAS: Seventy percent of Ferdinand's-Ha'Penny Restaurant floor staff has signed cards authorizing representation by Local 26 of the Hotel, Restaurant, Institutional Employees and Bartenders Union, AFL-CIO; and
- WHEREAS: The ownership of Ferdinand's -Ha'Penny has failed to respond to the employees' petition indicating a desire to be represented for purposes of collective bargaining by Local 26; and
- WHEREAS: The ownership of Ferdinand's-Ha'Penny has closed both restaurants, terminating almost seventy employees; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council supports the employees of Ferdinand's-Ha'Penny in their bid for collective bargaining with representation by Local 26, and opposes the closing of both restaurants without prior notice or warning.
