- WHEREAS: Dr. Kaunda is the founder and chairman of the Kenneth Kaunda Children of Africa Foundation, which is mobilizing international support for the youngest victims of the AIDS/HIV pandemic; and
- WHEREAS: In addition to bringing the morning message on February 23, 2003 at Western Avenue Baptist Church, Dr. Kaunda will receive the Martin Luther King, Jr. Good Samaritan Award in recognition of his many contributions to promoting democracy and human rights on the African continent; now therefore be it
