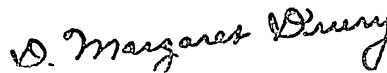

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$144,950 from the School Salaries and Wages account to the School Other Ordinary Maintenance account.

This transfer is related to the Elementary Consolidation Plan transition budgets that were approved for three schools as part of the FY04 School Budget. Each school received \$260,000 in transition funds to be expended as determined by each Principal. These additional resources were budgeted in the School Salaries and Wages account, pending decisions by each Principal. This transfer request reflects those decisions that have been made and requires funds be moved into the proper statutory category for expenditure.

The School Committee approved this transfer on July 29, 2003.
