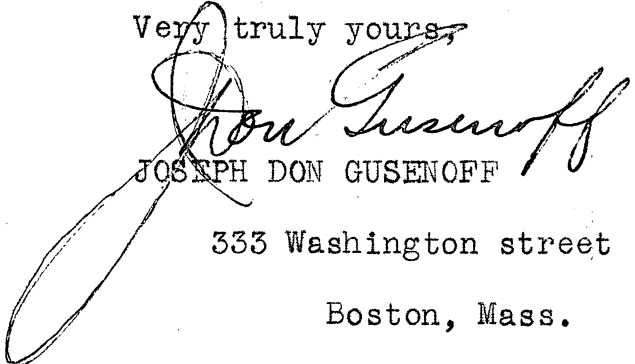
The undersigned respectfully pray s

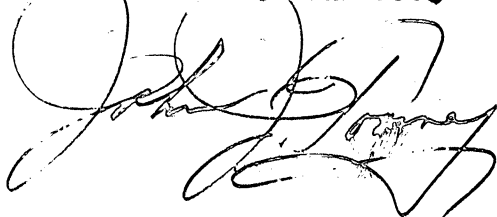
