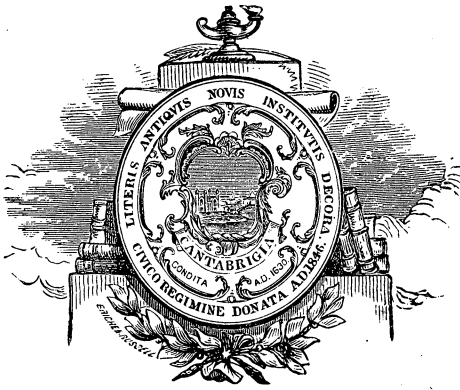




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Nov 17 1885.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that *Crescent Avenue* so called, *from Walden Street to Raymond Street*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet* in width between *said Walden Street and said Raymond Street,*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *Robert B. Palpey,* and dated *September, 1884,*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the* *several owners and abutters having waived the usual notice of such taking, and agreed to claim no such damages.*
