WHEREAS: On August 30, 1995, a Crime Walk was held by the North Cambridge Crime Task Force in the vicinity of Gladstone Street, Foch Street, Magoun Street, Matignon Ave, Muller Ave, and Madison Avenue, and

WHEREAS: This walk was attended by approximately forty people from the neighborhood who were concerned about the fact that there have been several breaks and attempted breaks in the neighborhood recently, and

WHEREAS: The following items were identified as needing attention from various city departments,

1. Mobil Station at corner of Alewife Brook Parkway needs notification concerning overgrown shrubbery in the vicinity of #4 Gladstone Street.
2. Trees need to be trimmed around streetlight in front of #8 Gladstone Street and #11 Richard Ave
3. Fair Oaks Street - all street lights out.
4. Foch Street - wire hanging low on end near Alewife Brook Parkway - right hand side, facing parkway.

RESOLVED: That The City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the proper departments to attend to these concerns as soon as possible, and report back to the City Council when completed.

WHEREAS: A community meeting was held at the Haggerty School and several items were brought forward by citizens who were concerned about conditions in the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS: Some of these concerns can be addressed at present, and some in the future; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the following list of concerns be directed to the appropriate department for action as soon as it is possible:

1. Present teams using Glacken Field on week-ends are leaving litter around the surrounding streets; parking illegally; selling food from the back of cars; alcoholic beverages being consumed in public by people in attendance;
2. Glacken Field be set aside for at least one Sunday during each month for use by neighborhood people for informal recreation.
3. Increased Police visibility during night time hours, especially in areas identified by residents as "hang-outs" for youths who are disturbing local residents.
4. Signage placed at Glacken Field indicating rules of Field regarding barbecues, drinking, vending, etc.; and be it further

RESOLVED: That a report be made back to the City Council as soon as possible regarding these issues.
