Enclosed please find a copy of the report by Officer Michael McMahon with regard to above, Cambridge Food Co-op.

Officer McMahon has spoken to the store manager and she is arranging to have smaller deliveries made at the Essex Street door and have employees monitor trucks for engines running unnecessarily.

The larger trucks requiring a ramp will have to deliver on Bishop Allen Drive between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. This will still create a problem as Bishop Allen Drive is a 2 way street with parking allowed only on one side. The side of the street where the back door of the Co-op is a "No Stopping" area.

Our solution would be to have the Store Manager contact the owner of the parking lot on Essex Street, at the side door of the store, (he is also landlord of Co-op) and arrange to have the trucks pull into the lot. As to whether the larger trucks can pull into this lot, there is still a question.

We will contact the Co-op Store Manager on this solution and advise you of the probability of further solutions. Until then, the status is as Officer McMahon reported.

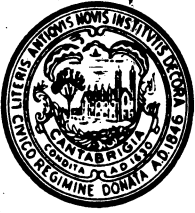
Sir:

At your request I responded to above location, and spoke with a Paula Gilbertson, the Store Manager regarding above council order. She informed me in the future she will make arrangements to have smaller deliveries made at the front door on Essex Street, and have employee monitor trucks for engines running unnecessarily.

Larger delivery trucks requiring a ramp have to be made on Bishop Allen Drive and this takes place between 7:00am and 3:00pm, Monday to Friday. In the event more than one truck arrives together she will have one wait on Essex Street as not to disturb abutters on Bishop Allen Drive.

She was very cooperative and willing to do what she can to remedy this problem. I will cooperate on any further problems.
