In order to plan the next phase of the inquiry regarding the contamination and flooding problems at the Grace site and the surrounding area, I would like to send any follow-up questions the Council may have to the officials who testified at the last meeting asking them to reply to the Committee in writing. Could you let me know any further concerns or questions you have from their testimony, from the testimony of the public and from the documents we have on file? I will try to compile these into one composite list and, with the City Manager's concurrence, send them along for response. While it is important to be comprehensive and thorough, I do hope we can compile a fairly brief, careful and tightly constructed list.

I would expect that we would have a further meeting to discuss the responses with officials on hand, if necessary, to give additional testimony.
