Auburn Streets for the purpose of conducting a musical performance on Tuesday, April 24, 1979 from 12 noon until 2 p.m.; and be it further

ORDERED:

That said permit is subject to the posting of a bond in the amount of One Thousand Dollars ^(\$1,000) and the holder of such permit shall be responsible for maintaining order on the premises. The Police Department shall have the right to revoke said permit if they deem necessary for just cause.
