-said construction or conversion is developed with four or more residential units and

-said residential units consist of approximately equal numbers of one-bedroom units, two-bedroom units, three-bedroom units and four-bedroom units (where "approximately equal" is defined as the number of each type of unit being no greater than one more, and no fewer than one less, than the number of all other types of units):

(1) the base FAR as set forth in section 17.24.1(1) shall be increased to 0.6;

(2) the Minimum Lot Area as set forth in section 17.24.2 (1) shall be decreased to one dwelling unit per 2100 square feet; and

(3) the maximum building height referenced in section 17.24. shall be increased to 40 feet, with a cornice height not to exceed 30 feet.
