- WHEREAS: October 2001 is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month; and
- WHEREAS: October 19, 2001 is National Mammography Day; and
- WHEREAS: An estimated 192,200 new cases of female breast cancer will be diagnosed in 2001 and 40,200 will die from the disease; and
- WHEREAS: An estimated 1,500 new cases of male breast cancer will be diagnosed in 2001 and 400 will die of this disease; and
- WHEREAS: Early detection and prompt treatment can significantly reduce suffering and deaths caused by this disease; and
- WHEREAS: Mammography, an "x-ray" of the breast, is recognized as the single most effective method of detecting breast changes that may be breast cancer long before physical symptoms can be seen or felt; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby proclaim the month of October 2001 as **National Breast Cancer Awareness Month** and October 19, 2001 as National Mammography Day in the City of Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Director of Health Programs, U.S. Conference of Mayors on behalf of the entire City Council.
